RESOLUTION #01-2021 TOWN OF CASSEL MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Resolution Setting the Amount of the 2021 Tax Roll Special Charge for Garbage/Recycling Service

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Cassel, Marathon County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under Wisconsin State Statutes, to adopt this resolution, and

WHEREAS, under Town of Cassel Ordinance No. 1214-2020 as adopted on January 11, 2021 the charges for garbage and recycling collection shall become a special charge against each residence in the Town of Cassel and the charge for such services shall be placed on the tax bill for the services rendered pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 66.0627, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cassel board shall by resolution set fees for the collection of residential garbage and recyclables. Said fees to include any administrative costs of the Town as well as the amount charges by the contracted garbage collection firm, and

WHEREAS, the garbage and recycling fee per residence to be charged by the contracted garbage collection firm to the Town of Cassel for 2021 is \$14.50 per month, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cassel incurred minimal if any additional administrative costs related to the garbage and recycling program during 2021 and accordingly will charge \$0.00 of additional costs to the residents, and

WHEREAS, the garbage and recycling program operated for 9 months during 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Town of Cassel the residential garbage and recycling program fee to be collected on the 2021 Real Estate Property Assessment Roll as a Special Charge is certified as \$130.50 per residence and is to be prorated for new construction residences.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under Wisconsin Statutes.
